## White House Creates Schedule G Category for Policy-Focused Appointments

**WASHINGTON, DC** – Today, Marcus Hill, President of the Senior Executives Association (SEA)–representing the interests of over 10,000 career federal executives in the Senior Executive Service (SES), Senior Level (SL), Scientific and Professional (ST) and equivalent positions and other senior career federal leaders, - released the following statement in response to the announcement of a new Schedule G personnel authority in the federal excepted service:

"The White House announcement of the Executive Order Creating Schedule G in the Excepted Service is a continuation of actions taken by the Trump Administration's that have the effect of politicizing work formerly done by career leaders within the federal workforce. (see prior SEA statements related to the politicization of the career federal civil service) This new employment authority undermines merit-based hiring to select qualified professionals to perform these critical jobs, replacing this system that has served Presidents of both parties over many decades with a system that will have the effect of rewarding political loyalists — what is often referred to as a "spoils system." Schedule G adds no discernable value to federal government's capabilities to accomplish agencies' missions. In fact, the addition of Schedule G complicates existing bureaucracies in a way that will diminish organizational and operational effectiveness. Inserting more political appointees into a federal government will not address critical needs to provide important services to the American People effectively and efficiently. Schedule G does not address real, longstanding challenges within the federal civil service system. SEA continues to be open to discussions with Trump Administration leaders on reforms that will strengthen the federal workforce's capacity to serve the nation."
